II. Position Presentation

- c. Side B presents their position using supporting evidence from the texts.
- d. Side A <u>restates</u> to Side B's satisfaction.

III. Consensus-Building

- a. Abandon roles.
- Build consensus regarding the question (or at least clarify where your differences lie), using supporting evidence.
- c. Consider the question:

How should we judge people from the past?
