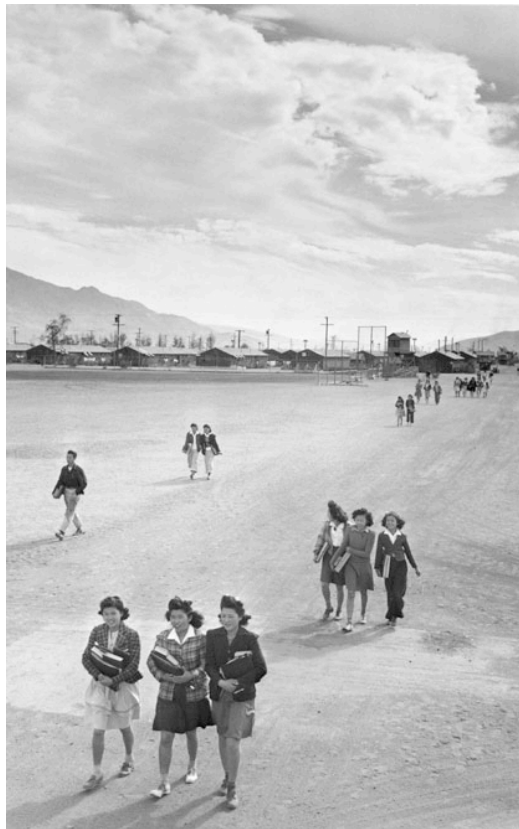


### Reading Photographs: A Dusty Street
