Published in 1954 in the Richmond, VA, newspaper Times-Dispatch, this editorial cartoon is artist Fred O. Seibel's reaction to the landmark U.S. Supreme Court decision *Brown v. Board of Education*. This case found segregated public schools unconstitutional, and declared that all such schools must desegregate.
