

## Carriages and Wagons



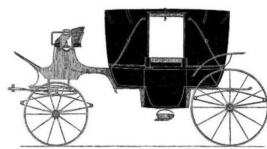

4. Landau

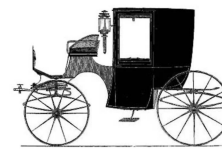

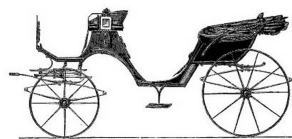

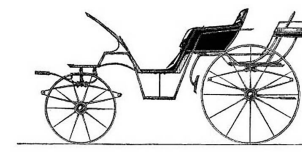
